Different variables of ID process were identified for the measurement based on literature review and real field situation. There were significant differences in formalization, physical resource, managerial ability, budget, curriculum development and human resource among the FFS members trained by Farmer Trainer and Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Trainer . The development and maintenance of human resource within a FFS is required for the continuity of FFS as an IPM training institution in a village. The conceptual framework included in this book is especially useful in determining the ID process of other grass root organizations of farmers as well.
