The agency has increased contracting significantly, and received funds in Fiscal Year 2002 to enter into a vessel time charter for a hydrographic vessel. In response to the need to modernize the U. S. hydrographic serv-ices program, Congress adopted the Hydrographic Services Im-provement Act of 1998 (HSIA), Title III of Public Law 105 - 384. NSIA authorizes NOAA to maintain sufficient equipment, per-sonnel, and expertise to ensure the quality of all data incorporated into United States nautical charts and other navigational products, and authorizes NOAA to select hydrographic contractors under Title IX of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 (the Brooks Act). The Brooks Act allows government agencies to let contracts on a qualifications basis rather than a cost basis for certain technical services.
